

Inclusion Faculty Facilities

The Inclusion Faculty has a range of well suited classrooms and most of them are well equipped with IT. We have a small Speech and Language Therapy room and other 1:1 spaces available in the library. There is a room dedicated for mentoring and supporting students with social and emotional needs. We call this the Daffon Centre. There is an Internal Exclusion room where students may have to serve an Internal Exclusion if they have not followed the Ladder of Consequence. Whilst in the Internal Exclusion students work in booths and are expected to complete classwork and catch up on work they may have fallen behind on. There is also a quiet space for students who need a space for silent study. We also have a delightful outdoor learning space where we can do gardening. We have a well-equipped room for delivering interventions and literacy support as well as a multisensory room where students can have 'calm time'.

Outdoor Learning takes place in the community and also in the garden. Here students grow a range of fruit, vegetables and flowers. We were donated a tree that was grown from the seed of one of the original trees in the orchard that was in this area for many years from the Tudor period.
