

This can include:

- Reading and spelling
- Learning new information and concepts
- Working with numbers
- Working memory
- Concentration
- Students may have conditions such as Specific Learning Difficulties, dyslexia, general learning difficulties, AD(H)D, Fragile X, Down Syndrome
- Students may present with difficulties that do not have a specific title

What can Nower Hill High School offer?

All students at Nower Hill High School can access

- Quality first teaching with appropriate differentiation (including best SEN practice)
- Visual aids to support key vocabulary, concepts and themes
- Access to homework support clubs
- Year 7 Oracy programme
- Accelerated Reader Programme
- Access to assessment for identification of significant needs
- Dedicated and caring staff who value all students regardless of ability

Support for targeted groups of students may include

- Blocks of 1:1 small group lessons that focus on a range of needs such as literacy, comprehension and spelling in the Inclusion Faculty
- Year 7 reading recovery group provision
- LEXIA
- Achieve 3000
- Renaissance Reading
- Renaissance Maths
- Word Shark
- Where needed, help from an external agency (e.g. Educational Psychologist)
- Teaching Assistant support in some lessons
- Entry Level Qualifications offered at Key Stage 4 for selected students
- At exam stage, some students can opt for Study Plus to have additional English and Maths support
- Functional Skills
- Transition Group
- Targeted lunch time clubs for vulnerable students
- Handwriting Support Intervention Group

Targeted individual support may include:

- Ongoing tailor made 1:1 tuition in the Inclusion Faculty, led by a specialist teacher or teaching assistant
- Where needed, help from an external agency (e.g. Educational Psychologist)
- Appropriate testing for students with literacy difficulties to review and plan
- Subject specialist teaching assistants in key subjects to provide ongoing support
- External agency advice where needed
- Exam Access Arrangements
- Post 16 Transition support
