

How are the School's resources allocated and matched to children's special educational needs?

The school receives funding to respond to the needs of students with SEN from a number of sources that includes:

- A proportion of the funds allocated per student to the school to provide for their education called the Age Weighted Pupil Unit.
- The Notional SEN budget. This is funding devolved to schools to support them to meet the needs of students with SEN.

For those students with the most complex needs, the school may be allocated additional educational needs funding from the Local Authorities High Needs SEN Funding allocation (13/14: £233,367, 14/15: £271,610, 15/16: £413,928, 16/17: £423,612, 17/18: £464,440, 18/19: £436,871) plus we fund a nurse and college counsellor (13/14: £78,360, 14/15: £79,378, 15/16: £78,096, 16/17: £82,532, 17/18: £83,012, 18/19: £78,850).
