## Year 10 Key Dates

At the start of another important academic year, I am writing to inform you of some of the key dates over the coming months. Please read through the following and do not hesitate to contact us if you require any further information.

### Important dates

- **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> November – Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2018**

Teachers are tracking student progress during this period and writing tracking reports to be sent home.

- **Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019: Mock interview day**

Students will be provided with an appointment time during which they will be interviewed by a local employer. All Year 10 students will produce a Curriculum Vitae in preparation for this day and their CV will be used as the basis of the interview. Students will be provided with feedback on how to improve their interview skills.

- **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March – Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2019**

Teachers are tracking student progress during this period and writing tracking reports to be sent home.

- **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April – Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019: End of year examinations.**

Mock examinations will take a similar format to the GCSE examinations to prepare students for their formal examinations, whilst also providing additional information on student progress.

- **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2019: Work experience.**

All students in Year 12 are provided with a work experience placement, however we also offer the opportunity to a selected number of Year 10 students. Parents/carers will be provided with more details closer to the time.

- **Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019: Year 10 Parents'/Carers' Evening 3.00pm-7.30pm.**

Parents/carers will have the opportunity to discuss the progress of their child with subject teachers.

- **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June – Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2019**
